Fall 2000	First meeting in Atlanta that “gave birth” to NHAHA
June 1, 2002	Community planning Meeting that shaped NHAHA’s structure
March 2003	NHAHA was incorporated
June 2003	NHAHA co-sponsored a town hall meeting in collaboration with “Out of Many One” (OMO) in Brooklyn
June 2003	NHAHA hosted first New York region meeting at the Office of Minority Health
June 2004	NHAHA launched its major initiative called the <i>“Healthy Haitians 2010”</i> adapted from the nation “Healthy people 2010” first community Mental Health forum
Fall 2004	First annual national conference on Haitian health: <i>“Building on Our Achievements and Meeting New Challenges”</i> in Queens, New York
